Three of the five general education courses MUST be completed before admission into the Surgical Technology Program.

Two of the five general-education courses may be taken concurrently with the Surgical Technology courses BUT ONLY ONE COURSE MAXIMUM MAY BE TAKEN PER SEMESTER.

Program Description	The Surgical Technology program prepares individuals for employment as an integral part of a surgical team. Surgical technologists work closely with surgeons, anesthesiologists, registered nurses, and other surgical staff in delivering patient care and assuming appropriate responsibilities before, during and after surgery. Application required. Selective admission and enrollment is limited to 10 students. The program consists of classroom and laboratory instruction on campus and clinical instruction in clinic and hospital settings in the surrounding area. After successful completion of all academic and practicum work, graduate will be eligible to sit for the national certification exam for the surgical technology program administered by the National Board of Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting (NBSTSA). After successful completion of this exam the graduate will be a certified surgical technologist (CST). Graduation from this program does not presume or imply that students will be certified.
Program Requirements	70 TOTAL Program Credit Hours; Minimum of 2.0 GPA; all pre-requisite AND program courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better; This program requires an application and has selective admission.
