Program Description	This degree option includes all of the general education courses required for the Associate of Arts degree plus additional courses from education. This degree option is intended to accommodate students interested in transferring their coursework into a baccalaureate program in Teacher Education. Students who meet the graduation requirements of the ASE degree and who apply to one of these institutions may be granted admission to the Teacher Education program as juniors without loss of credits earned at SouthArk.
	Students must successfully pass the PRAXIS I test (ets.org) or show ACT scores that meet state requirements prior to being accepted into a teacher education program.
