In program Fall and Spring Semesters (GPS 4^{th} & 5^{th} Semesters) contain a total of 15 weeks off campus clinical rotation requirements occurring Monday through Friday. Students within the PTA Program during the 4^{th} & 5^{th} Fall/Spring Semesters will not be able to participate in additional face to face courses or campus related face to face activities outside of PTAP courses.

Program Description	This program prepares graduates to provide physical therapy services in various settings with a wide variety of patient populations. The program consists of lecture, lab practicums, and clinical rotation experiences.
Program Requirements	74 TOTAL program credit hours. Application to program by deadline required. Selective admissions process. Minimum requirements: ATI TEAS - see https://www.southark.edu/academics/health-science/teas-exam ; Must earn a "B" or better required in all BIOL courses, KINS, and PTAP 1002; "C" or better in non-BIOL, non-KINS, and non-PTAP 1002 pre-requisite courses; "C' or better in all program courses; Pass a criminal background check; PT clinical observations; Letters of recommendation

Licensure	In order to become licensed and work as a physical therapist assistant, a PTA graduate must pass a national board test, and fulfill licensure requirements within the state they will work in.
Career Opportunities	PTA graduates find employment in a variety of healthcare facilities and departments, including, but not limited to, acute care, rehab, out-patient, school system, home health, nursing homes, and pediatric settings. Average entry-level annual salary \$50,000
Transfer Paths and Requirements	A Doctorate of Physical Therapy, DPT, is the terminal degree to become a physical therapist. It requires a bachelor's degree followed by the completion of a CAPTE accredited PT graduate school. There are multiple PT schools within Arkansas. There are only two colleges in the USA that offer a bridge PTA-to-PT degree program, neither of these are within Arkansas.
